6. Maintenance of SAREA website.
7. Other activities that support rock climbing education.

SAREA applies the following principles to Supporter acknowledgement:

1. It is a priority of SAREA to acknowledge support.
2. The benefits for each Supporter level are transparent.
3. Support provided in any year receives acknowledgement until the end of following year.
4. Payment can be in-kind, direct remuneration or a combination.
