



## Artificial Climbing Structure Supervisor workshop 2025

SAREA is the South Australian Rockclimbing Education Association and has been serving South Australia since 1981. It was established to assist rock climbers in gaining leadership skills and accreditation to become competent guides and instructors. The SAREA guide and instructor programs will not teach you how to climb.

SAREA offers an Artificial Climbing Structure Supervisor Qualification Training program. This is not a learn-to-climb workshop, the focus will be on running through the skills and knowledge required for Assessment and to prepare and set up your wall to Australian Standards.

### **Workshop Training Scope:**

1. Provide advice for artificial climbing wall top rope climbing.
2. Review site safety inspection reports and conduct site safety inspection for each climbing session.
2. Set up all artificial climbing wall in preparation for top rope climbing.
3. Tie participants in appropriately and conduct safety checks.
4. Instruct participants to maximum of 2 belays, with an additional belay if 1 competent assistant and a further additional belay with 2 competent assistants
5. Supervise group management
6. Comply with OHS&W and risk management guidelines
7. Provide advice regarding care of equipment
8. Conduct simple rescues in an artificial climbing wall environment

### **Prerequisites**

This is not a learn to climb course. You should have a basic understanding of climbing equipment and have some experience with belaying and tying knots. Course notes will be provided before the course. No lead climbing is required.

### **Price - \$150**

**Dates for 2025:** One course is scheduled for – **March 16, 10am to 4pm**. Further courses can be run on demand, with a minimum of three participants required per workshop.
